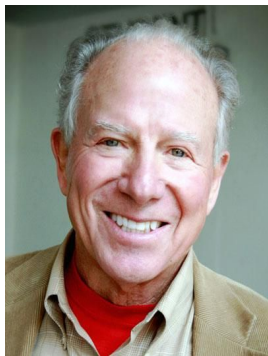
“Watch, Listen, Play, Create”
